Thank you for playing Pike Fest 2011. Preorder apparel coming soon.

Today we will send you three important emails: Coach info; parent info; and this email with all the Team Manager info.

TEAM MANAGER INFO

Team check-in takes place at the Tournament Headquarters Tent at the Mary & John Geisse Soccer Complex on Friday, August 19, 5:00 PM - 8:00 PM and Saturday, August 20, 7:00 AM - 10:00 AM. Although you may check in either day, we encourage nearby teams, and teams with games scheduled for early Saturday morning, to check-in on Friday. Please note "HQ" tent on the map on page three of the field maps <http://www.pikefest.org/directionsfieldlayout.pdf>

Please bring the following items to check-in:

. A copy of your team's official 2011-2012 state issued team roster. (IYSA teams without official roster may print a trial roster from your team's IYSA GotSoccer account.)

. A Pike Fest Tournament Roster Form listing all players (regular and guest players). Please bring two completed copies of this form. We will keep one and officials will use your copy during the tournament (instead of player cards). This is Pike Fest's ONLY unique form. Please have it completed before check in. . Medical Release Form. You need a form for each player on your Tournament Roster. You may use your own form. Medical Release forms do NOT need to be notarized. If you need one, it is posted on www.pikefest.org

. 2011-2012 fall player passes if available. If you've not received your 2011-2012 player passes, you may use last year's player passes and bring a letter or email from your state organization stating the roster is in the works. Often a state organization may provide a team with a copy of the, as yet, unofficial roster to use. >>Please bring copy of birth certificates with a current photo for each player who does not yet have a valid player card.<<

. Up to three U15 players are allowed per U14 team. U15 players must be on the U14 team's state roster and are not allowed to be guest players.

. Out of state teams must obtain a "permit to travel" form from local U.S. Youth Soccer affiliated association and give it to the team check in person.

. Hotel Information. If you're staying overnight, please let us know which hotel by completing this information on the bottom of the Team Check In sheet (we provide this sheet at Check In). Still need hotels? Visit hotel page for info on IVCB help <http://www.pikefest.org/hotels.html> All teams must use IVCB for hotel reservations in order to be certain the team is staying in a good hotel.

U9 AND U10 TEAMS: Please pick up your team's Participation Awards at the MJGSC main tent. It would be great, and likely save you a trip, if you picked them up during Team Check In.

For Indiana Soccer association teams: state office has run out of blank player pass card stock. Although a few clubs/teams have passes, the majority of Indiana Soccer association clubs do NOT. NOT TO WORRY. Pike Fest check in folks know the work around.

For Pike Fest this weekend, we will allow teams to play with their state roster and birth certificates to prove age. The roster will prove registration (insurance). Any player not on a roster cannot be allowed to participate. If the team is using a guest player from another team in your club, please bring a copy of that team's roster too. (On a roster=insured.)

For any team that is registered with IYSA, GotSoccer has a roster in their team account that they can print. Except U9-10 academy pools: U9-U10 IYSA Academy teams, please ask Sarah Cantwell at IYSA to create a roster for your team.
